many dogs at once. Focus on quality over quantity, ensuring each interaction is a positive learning experience.

Basic Obedience Commands: Building Communication

"Sit": The First Step to Control

Again, start with luring and gradually fade the lure, relying on the verbal cue.

Managing Nipping and Biting

When your puppy nips too hard, yelp loudly, mimicking a littermate's reaction. Immediately withdraw attention for a few seconds. If the nipping persists, redirect their chewing to an appropriate chew toy. Offer praise and treats when they chew on their toys. This teaches them what is acceptable to chew. For persistent mouthing, consider a **positive reinforcement dog trainer** to help guide you through techniques like bite inhibition.

Preventing Destructive Chewing
