2. **Navigate to the Video's Location:** Browse through the various locations (On My iPad, iCloud Drive, other connected cloud services) to find the folder containing your video.
3. **Select the Video:** Tap and hold on the video file you wish to delete. A context menu will appear.
4. **Choose 'Delete':** From the context menu, select 'Delete'.
5. **Confirm Deletion:** A confirmation prompt will appear. Tap 'Delete' to confirm.

Unlike the Photos app, deleting a file directly from the Files app usually removes it permanently immediately, without a 'Recently Deleted' stage for most locations. specific cloud service if the video was stored there.
